



The Australian Institute of Music 'Rock the Schools' Scholarship Offer Terms & Conditions

The Australian Institute of Music (AIM) is offering a **10% Bachelor of Music, Audio Technology Scholarship** to an applicant who is deemed worthy of such. Applicants are expected to apply through the Admissions department at AIM following the necessary procedures.

In an interview with the Head of Department, applicants have to provide a CD portfolio of recorded work that best illustrates their ability as either an engineer and/or producer. The applicant is expected to supply 3 examples of their work. These recordings will help us to establish the level at which the applicant has achieved in audio. If applicants are unable to present any recorded works either original or otherwise a resume of any audio and music related experience will be assessed accordingly.

The interview process will include a short interview to discuss applicants' experience in music and audio as well as an assessment of musicianship skills. A knowledge of the basic theory components of music will be required to be considered a successful applicant. You will also be expected to discuss your career and study aspirations.

Once applicants received their Higher School Certificate (or equivalent) they will be required to send a copy into AIM.

The Australian Institute of Music is a music school which has been preparing young Australians for music careers since 1968. Since that time, it has evolved and developed into the major independent music education provider in Australia. AIM music courses are recognised throughout Australia for delivering exceptional music tuition and unique industry focused program, designed to provide the skills and ability to build a lifelong career in the music and creative industries. As an AIM scholarship holder you are an ambassador for the Institute and will be called upon to help promote and assist the Institute at various times throughout your study.

The scholarship auditions are conducted by the Dean, and the Heads of Department. In the scholarship interviews applicants are required to submit a portfolio for the panel and then enter into a discussion about their career and study aspirations. This scholarship will last for the length of the course studied at AIM provided that the student meets all the terms of the scholarship.

Terms and Conditions of the Australian Institute of Music Scholarships

- Scholarship holders must not receive a grade of fail for any unit of study;
- Scholarship holders must achieve a grade of Distinction or higher in Major Study units;
- Scholarship holders must attend all scheduled classes - only absence due to illness (supported by a medical certificate) and approved absences are permitted; and
- Scholarship holders will contribute to external activities of AIM where requested.

AIM reserves the right to withhold offering a Scholarship if the appropriate person is not identified within the requirements listed above.
